- **1 Corinthians 11:27** So, then, whoever eats the bread or drinks the cup of the Lord in an unworthy manner will be guilty of sin against the body and blood of the Lord. Let a person examine himself; in this way let him eat the bread and drink from the cup.
- -This observance is for followers of Christ.
- **1 Corinthians 11:23-24** For I received from the Lord what I also passed on to you: On the night when he was betrayed, the Lord Jesus took bread, and when he had given thanks, broke it, and said, "This is my body, which is for you. Do this in remembrance of me."

Romans 10:9 If you confess with your mouth, "Jesus is Lord," and believe in your heart that God raised him from the dead, you will be saved.

-Let's examine ourselves in God's light.

Psalm 139:23 &24 Search me, God, and know my heart; test me and know my thoughts. See if there is any offensive way in me; lead me in the everlasting way.

Unconfessed Sin, **1 John 1:9**, "If we confess our sin, he is faithful and just to forgive our sin and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness."

Steps of obedience, **1 John 2:3**, "And by this we know that we have come to know Him, if we keep His commandments."

Our walk with Him, **Luke 9:23** And He was saying to them all, "If anyone wishes to come after Me, he must deny himself, and take up his cross daily and follow Me."

2 Timothy 2:21 So if anyone purifies himself from anything dishonorable, he will be a special instrument, set apart, useful to the Master, prepared for every good work.

Are you ready? If so then let's thank God and remember the broken body and shed blood of Jesus as often as you do this. 1 Corinthians 11:23-36
