A. It's a picture of what happened to Jesus - His death, burial and resurrection.
B. The picture of Jesus' death, burial and resurrection was the very act of Jesus dying as our Substitute and Representative.
2.A
A. It's a statement describing what happens to a believer when he/she professes faith in Christ. Galatians 2:20 "I have been crucified with Christ, and I no longer live, but Christ lives in me. The life I now live in the body, I live by faith in the Son of God, who loved me and gave himself for me."
Ephesians 2:1-5
B. Water baptism is a declaration of the greatest act that can happen in a life - salvation.
3.Anof obedience Matthew 28:19-20a
A. It is a necessary part of having fellowship with Christ. "Go, therefore, and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, teaching them to observe everything I have commanded you."
 B. Though baptism is not necessary for salvation, the believer wants to be baptized.
